An annual event that builds relationships across teams and provides an opportunity for sharing knowledge about innovations and advancements across the kidney care continuum.

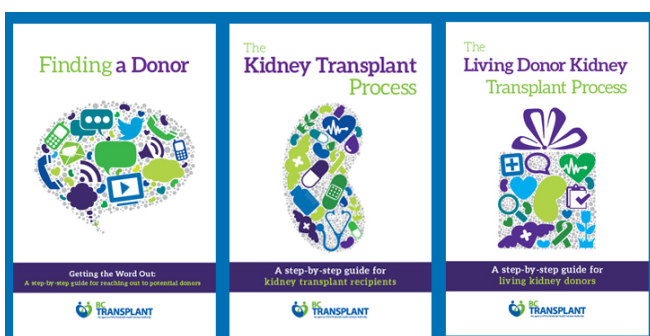

BCT implements an activity-based funding model for the renal transplant group. As with BCPRA's funding model, it follows the patient as he or she moves through the system. BCT is now working to adapt the model to support the needs of other transplant groups.
