Re: Transport of Medical Equipment and Medicines

To whom it may concern:

_____ is currently a patient in my care and receiving Peritoneal Dialysis treatment, a life sustaining therapy for kidney disease. Therapy consists of peritoneal dialysis treatments daily using a peritoneal dialysis cyclor machine. This patient is travelling and will therefore be carrying one or more of the following items:

- **Baxter or Fresenius peritoneal dialysis cyclor with travel case**
- **Stickman portable peritoneal dialysis solution warmer**
- **Cassettes, drain lines and drain bags.**
- **Boxes of dialysis solution.**
- **Heparin, needles and syringes.**
- **Cleansing solutions, dressings, clamps and minicaps**
- **Medications (injectables and oral)**

These supplies should be treated like prescription medications.

It should be noted that one or more of these supplies and/or medicines are affected by extreme temperatures and should be included in carry-on luggage. Please allow this patient to pass through security to board his/her flight with these medications and supplies.

A current list of medications is attached.

The above patient is stable on Peritoneal Dialysis and approved for travel.
