

Replavite / Renavite

What it does:

This medication is a vitamin supplement designed for people with kidney disease. It contains water-soluble vitamins: vitamin C and B vitamins including folic acid.

How it works:

This medication provides the water-soluble vitamins that may be lost during dialysis or deficient in your diet. These nutrients are important for health including the production of red blood cells.

How to take it:

Take this vitamin once daily with food and after dialysis if possible. DO NOT take more or less than is prescribed.

What to do if you miss a dose:

If you forget to take a dose, take it as soon as you remember. If you do not remember the missed dose until the next day, just skip the missed dose. DO NOT double your dose.

Possible side effects:

Stomach upset may occur. Contact your doctor if any of the side effects persist or become severe and intolerable.
